
Mongol Status

Local Status Report

- The government submitted its first report according to the disabled peoples' human rights agreement approved by the UNO 62-1 general meeting's decision.
- However, there are still many tasks remaining such as the disabled peoples' employment act
- We are anticipating a new disabled peoples' human rights improvement paradigm through this years' national assembly election
- DPI Mongol is currently a non-government organization that currently doesn't receive any government support


Achievements over 2 years

Achievement Report

- Pursuing to participate in the 61st UNO general assembly for the disabled peoples' human rights treaty approval
- Newly constructed a 1 and 2 floor building in the Arbaikhur & Bayank Hongor provinces, and Nalaikh district through the support of Finland Flom, Pulbburi (grassroots) Japan, and other such foreign donation organizations. Special kindergarten for disabled children is in operation in these buildings, and it is also being conveniently used as office facilities for the local organizations.
- * The local disabled people visiting Ulaanbaatar city are able to use public transportation for free as temporary residents in the city.
- Currently participating in a board of directors named "Tagshi Durun" (Place full of equality) through financial support from Italian AIFO non-government Organization to deal with problems and issues that they are currently facing.




Achievement Report2

- The ministries of social welfare & labour are pursuing to be included in the national committee for disabled peoples' support
- Making efforts to establish a long-term cooperative agreement with major city labour & welfare service departments
- We have filed complaints to the ministry of social welfare & labour, and the provincial labour safety department regarding the non-fulfillment of disabled peoples' human rights regulations and the delays in administrative tasks in relations to disabled persons. We are making demands to the provincial committee to fulfill the approved legislations.



Achievement Report3

- Initiate the "Abundant environment" Campaign on May 13th of every year to urge the fulfillment of disabled peoples' human rights regulations and also to propagate the applicable Mongolian legislative articles.
- Within the range of the disabled peoples' human rights regulation Article 29, which states "participate in social/political activities", regulated during the 2012 Mongolian National assembly election, pursue election related projects such as preparing voting sites for disabled people for the disabled people to widely participate in politics.



1. Earthquake Rescue Activities

- * Through the alliance of ILC Japanese National Assembly & the Yumekase foundation, a rescue headquarters was established for the disabled victims of the Tohoku Kanto earthquake. "Major Disaster Centers" were established in 3 *hyuns* that were affected by the earthquake to participate in disabled people support activities.
- Cooperative efforts are being made with the JDF (Japanese Disabled peoples' Forum) headquarters to submit emergency rescue inquisition reports and proposal reports to the Japanese Government in order to provide comprehensive support for the disabled victims of the Tohoku Kanto earthquake.

2. International Cooperation



- * Participated in the 8th international general assembly held in Durban, South Africa in October of 2011.
- Attended the ESCAP professionals' meeting in December of 2011. Shoji Nakanishi attended the ESCAP government forum, which is one of civilian social organizations, as the chairman of DPAI-AP.
- * The "Disabled peoples' main streaming for the IL programs of Africa" training program, hosted by the Japanese International Cooperative Association (JICA), is initiated in English and French speaking countries.
- The "Disabled peoples' HIV/AIDS training through the competence improvement of the disabled peoples' organization for the hearing impaired (Tampopo Project)", which is one of the JICA-Pulbburi cooperative project in Brazil, was completed on September 11th 2011, and the 2nd phase will proceed until March of 2013.
