

#### **Older Adults**

 People aged 60 and over will rise to 25% of the population in the next 20 years.

#### **Persons with impairments**

- 1.9 million persons with disabilities, consisting of about 2.9 % of the entire population (63 million persons)
- 750,389 (58.6%) male and 439,697 (41.4%) female persons with disabilities
- 116,468 registered children with disabilities, of which 57,751 are boys and 58,747 are girl

- 1. Welfare model provided by government sectors,
- 2. The double welfare model collaborated by government sectors and private sectors,
- 3. The multiple inclusive sectors welfare model and collaborating among multistakeholders in the community.

### Conclusion

- 1. Social welfare and protection should be a central element of the development agenda.
- 2. Investment in children, women, persons with disability, and people of all age and reducing vulnerability of people at risk will assist countries to develop their human potential, reduce poverty, achieve sustainable growth by enhancing production and create opportunities for individual self-reliance.



## Conclusion (con't)

3. Paradigm shift of the development is to engage persons with disabilities and vulnerable people in social development processes in term of right base approach rather than charity based approach.

Utilize their expertise would be a great support and reduce social worker depression.



## Conclusion (con't)

4. The most crucial aspect of human security usually is in the area of human dignity; the lack of political voices, legal rights, access to justice and the ability to contest discrimination so the poor people always deprive of their rights.

Because a current paradigm of development partnership had not get sufficiency engaged vulnerable people especially persons with disabilities who live in the rural area in ASEAN.




## Disability in ASEAN
