Nawabshah Disability Forum in collaboration of IOM (International organization for Migration) organized 3 days training on CCCM (Camp Coordination & Camp Management) on 17th -19th April 2013 in Nawabshah District Shaheed Benazir Abad. The IOM Trainers Ms. Amber Gaho & Mr. Raja Faheem Khokhar delivered their sessions with dedication to spread the IOM mandate & about CCCM. The trainers told that In recent years, Pakistan has experienced natural disasters like earth quake in 2005, flood 2010-11-12. The disasters affected nearly 20 million

people, many people were forced out of their homes and identified as in need for assistance & protection. They said IOM is international body/ INGO working for the protection of migrants. Its activities contribute to protecting human rights, having the effect of protecting persons involved in migration. As the global cluster lead for Camp Coordination & Camp Management & accordance of needs of the







affected population, the IOM has developed CCCM a capacity building



programme. It was shared that during the camp management the shelter, the food, the water & the sanitations are called services. Meanwhile the education, the health, safety & livelihood are called protection. During natural disasters the people are forced to leave their homes, loose access to shelter, food, water, sanitation, education, health & safe place to live. They use to live in camps or tent cities. The camp management is about how the relocation site is organized, to meet the basic needs for services

& protection of its residents. Every person should participate in the camp management activities to improve the quality of life of their community. The international standards of dignified life have been defined to uphold the right to life with dignity for people living in the camps. The life cycle of relocation sites was shared the there are three phases that relocation site will follow: (1) The planning & set up of relocation site, (2) The care & maintenance (3) The closure & durable solution for the relocation sites.

The community groups are formed from resident population like water committee to ensure safe drinking water, the sanitation committee to ensure sanitation in the camp, the health committee to ensure healthy environment, education committee to ensure education of resident children, the security committee to ensure safety

& protection of resident population.



The Camp Manager is responsible for the overall management of camp and the referral of needs to service providers.

There are many camp management activities like registration, information collection, food distribution, schooling option, access to water, livelihood, monitoring standards, camp maintenance, community participation, sanitation & health & security.

The participants of different NGOs including NDF members showed keen interest to get involved in all the process & participated in all the activities as active participants.

Mr. Abid Lashari NDF President acknowledged the services of IOM to avail facilitation regarding CCCM training; he said that it was great opportunity for small NGOs' participants to enhance their knowledge. He appreciated the training style of both trainers who engaged the participants for three days. He hoped from IOM for future collaboration with NDF Nawabshah.
